

Main Parade Rules and Information June 21st, 10 a.m.

This year's parade will begin at the North end of Fort McKay, at the Keyano College building. Our theme this year is **Celebrating the 125th Anniversary of the signing of the Treaty.**


All floats and parade participants should be at the Keyano College building by no later than 9:30 a.m. The parade will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. and conclude at 11:00 a.m. Security will be closing the road for regular traffic and will be on the parade route.

Parade Rules:

- 1. DO NOT throw or shoot anything from moving vehicles (including candy, water, or paper). Walkers MAY pass giveaways to parade watchers.
- 2. DO NOT hang off the sides of moving vehicles.
- 3. DO be very careful any time you are on, behind, or next to a moving float.
- 4. DO WATCH ALL CHILDREN IN YOUR ENTRY VERY CAREFULLY!
- 5. DO keep within 20-30 feet of the entry in front of you.
- 6. DO NOT stop during the parade, except to keep your spacing or during an emergency.
- 7. NO alcoholic beverages are allowed before or during the parade by any parade participant. Anyone violating these rules will not be allowed to participate and will be asked to leave the parade area.
- 8. DO share these rules with everyone participating in your entry.
